

Printing from MyChart


It is possible to print from MyChart when using the MyChart website at <https://mychart.eehealth.org/mychart>.

Printing a single page


Some pages are designed to be printed and there will be a printer icon on these pages. Printing these pages using the printer icon will add identifying items to the top of the printed page.

Example: Print a test result to present to an employer or school

1. Click the printer icon on the page you wish to print.



2. A print preview will open. Click **Print this page**.



Using this print method will add identifying information such as the patient's name.

Printing entire visits or records

One or more visits/encounters can be downloaded into a printable file. Use these steps to download a printable file.


1. Use the menu to search for **Document Center**.

2. Select **Visit Records**
3. There are several options **Single Visit, Date Range, All Visits, or *Lucy Summary**

*What is your Lucy Summary?

It is a portable copy of your allergies, medications, current health issues, procedures, test results, and immunizations from MyChart. You can put your Lucy record on a USB drive and take it with you to share with your other healthcare providers.

*Clinical Notes and After Visit Summaries are not included in a **Lucy Summary**. Choose a different option to print those.*



4. Click **Download**. Large files may take a few minutes.
 - a. You can log out of MyChart, and you will get an email when your file is ready.
 - b. You can also stay logged in while you wait. Click the Refresh link to check the status.
5. Once your download is complete you can find it on your **Requested Records** page.
6. Click on the **Download** button to view the file. **PLEASE NOTE downloads are .zip files and your computer will need the ability to unzip the files.**
7. Open the PDF file and print.
